CALL FOR POSTERS **Annual Meeting and Program** **March 15, 2013**

Proposals are invited from member schools for student and faculty poster presentations at the NCHASCN's 2013 annual meeting and program. Two student poster proposals per member school will be accepted. There is no limit on the number of poster proposals accepted from faculty of member schools.

Student posters will be evaluated on quality of content and organization, contribution and relevancy to the nursing profession, comprehensive handling of subject matter, and evidence of thorough understanding of subject matter, originality, creativity, and clarity. Monetary prizes of \$100.00 and \$50.00 respectively will be awarded for the two highest scoring student posters. A poster that has been prepared for a nursing course requirement may be submitted as a student poster presentation.

Poster proposals should be submitted on one page that includes:

1. Presenter(s) name(s) and credentials
2. Name, address, phone number and fax number of school
3. Title of poster
4. Objectives for poster

Poster presenters will be notified of acceptance by March 4, 2013. Poster presenters desiring to attend the program/meeting will be responsible for their own transportation and registration fees.

Poster Guidelines

1. The poster must be free standing, for display on a table. Poster materials are at the presenter's discretion.
2. A school faculty member must be present to oversee poster setup and to ensure poster removal at the completion of the day.
3. A half sheet of paper or index card with the following typed information should accompany the poster:
 - a. Title of poster
 - b. Presenter(s) name(s)
 - c. Name of school, city, and state
